

COURT ADJOURNS TO HEAR SICK WITNESS

**Assistant Yardmaster Says He
Saw Boswell in Yards on
Day of Insult.**

The Hays murder trial was adjourned at 10:30 a. m. Tuesday so attorneys could secure a deposition from W. D. Harter, assistant Texas & Pacific yardmaster, who is a witness for the defense. He is sick.

The defense directed an attack on the

testimony of Special Agent Mansker, who testified that he was with R. E. Boswell during the entire afternoon of May 7, the date of the alleged insult offered to Miss Ruth Hays by Boswell, and that Boswell never left his office till 6 o'clock.

Harter testified he saw Boswell out in the Texas & Pacific yards on the afternoon of May 7.

There is little hope that the case will go to the jury before tomorrow night.

A. J. Anderson testified that a few days before the killing of Boswell a man whom he believed was Hays came into his store and bought shells.
