

BAD MAN TAKEN BY OFFICERS OF UNION COUNTY

Bandit Who Held Up Sheep
Camp Near Clayton Several
Days Ago Is Captured and
Pleads Guilty.

Clayton, N. M., Feb. 15.—Sheriff H. T. Mansker today brought into Clayton the man who attempted to hold up a sheep camp near Clayton several days ago and who shot and seriously wounded a sheep herder in a pistol duel which followed. The prisoner refused to give his name, but pleaded guilty, and will be sentenced by the judge of the district court in due time.

During his flight after the affair at the sheep camp the unknown bandit shot and wounded a farmer. The posse in pursuit of him was out a week before the capture was finally made.
