

Rules Listed For Arguments On Charter Poll

City Clerk Ed Nielsen yesterday said any individual or organization wishing to submit written arguments for or against the city's single proposal on the June 8 ballot, must do so by 5 p.m. April 20.

Nielsen, in announcing that necessary concurrence had been received from the county and school board for consolidating the election, said arguments must not exceed 300 words.

The city measure is a "straw vote" indicating to the City Council whether it should call an election on the question: "Shall a Charter Commission be elected to propose a new charter or revise the current charter?"

Ballot arguments will not be accepted unless accompanied by the name or names of the person or persons submitting it. No more than five signatures shall appear with any argument, said Nielsen.

Arguments will be mailed with the sample ballot to all registered voters.
