Final arrangements were complete yesterday for the program that will mark the formal opening of the city's new \$4,600 band shell at Plant Park at 8 o'clock tonight...

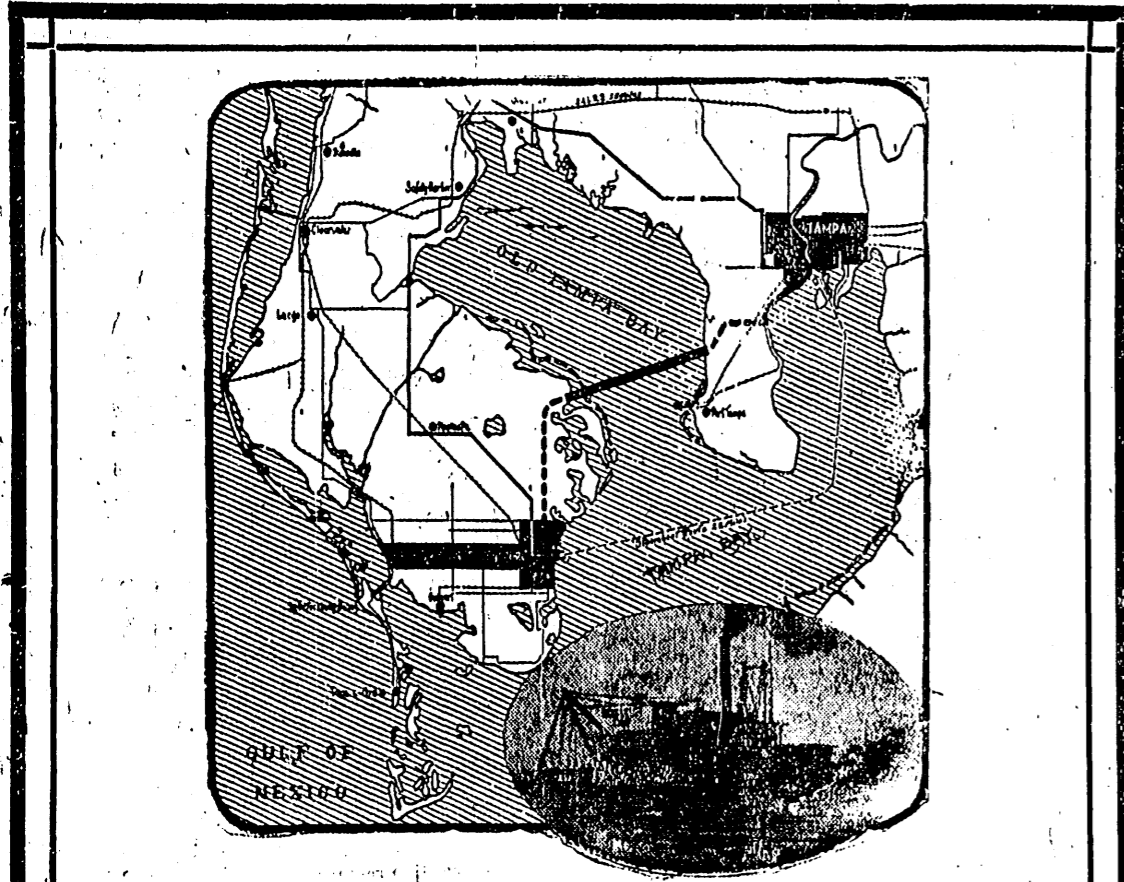
MRS. GUSTAVE AYALA DIES AT HOME HERE; FUNERAL 3:30 TODAY
