

Eastern Side Of Jones Pool Gets Spread

STAMFORD, Texas, Dec. 9.—Lewis Production Company No. 1 San Antonio Land Bank Saturday apparently had extended the Griffin pool of Jones County two locations east. Operators drilled saturated Palo Pinto lime from 3,245-75 feet, and the test began heading through casing but would not flow through tubing. Operators set a packer ten feet off bottom and are swabbing. Location is in the southwest quarter of section 198, BBB&C survey, and a south offset to Hammond No. 1 Rial, a failure at 3,296 feet.

Humble Oil & Refining Company No. 4 R. B. Spencer, on the west side of the original Avoca pool, topped the lime at 3,215 feet and drilled saturation from 3,220-30 feet. The well came in natural, gauging 69 barrels of oil per hour through casing. It is in section 195-BBB&C.

Iron Mountain Oil Company is rigging up spudder at a northeast outpost in the Ivy pool of Shackelford County. The test will be No. 4 Coker-Mansker and is in section 159-BBB&C.

Jones-Stasney et al. No. 1 Wentz, wildcat two miles northeast of the Ivy pool, logged a show of oil in Bluff Creek sand at 1,598-1,602 feet and drilled ahead past 1,900 feet. It is in section 13-3-H&TC.

K. B. Nowles No. 1 Pardue, Haskell County wildcat three miles northeast of Stamford, is drilling past 1,852 feet. Location is in section 1-SFIW.
