ACTING JUDGE WILLIAMS ISSUES ORDER

Six Cases Resulting From Liquor Raids to Be Tried Later

Further continuance of the six liquor cases resulting from raids and arrests made by the police department last week were made when the docket was opened yesterday morning by Acting Municipal Judge J. E. Williams.

The six cases, two against Joe Licata, and one each against the following: Celestino Miranda, L. L. Isenace, Orton Bailey and M. M. Henry were set for hearing on Jan. 30.

Phillip Licata, arrested on a charge of carrying concealed weapons at the time Joe Licata's place was raided by officers last week, was convicted of that charge, and sentenced by judge to a fine of \$25.

J. Trautman, who said he was seventy-one years of age, was fined \$20 on two charges, one of trespassing on private property and the other peddling in the city without a license.

High Court Affirms Judge Robles Order in the White Case

An order from the state supreme court confirming the decision of Judge F. M.
