Boy Arrested and Placed Under Bond—Officers Hunting Negro Woman

As the result of a noon-hour altercation yesterday between two boys employed at Swift & Company's plant, Bay Stitt, aged 14 years, received a knife wound in the right shoulder and Preston Parkham, about the same age, was arrested by Special Officer A. J. Mansker. Parkham had preliminary hearing before Justice Rowland who placed him under \$300 bonds on charge of assault to murder. Stitt's wound was dressed by Dr. Gilmore and is not considered serious.
