

PROHIBITORY WRIT DENIED TO MANSKER BY SUPREME COURT

Santa Fe, Sept. 8.—The case of the State vs. Richard Ascarate, of Las Cruces, from Lincoln county, was argued and submitted before the supreme court today. Ascarate had been sentenced to ten years on the charge of manslaughter. The Eaton Water Works company case was submitted on briefs, as was the case of George W. Prichard vs J H Fulmer, Jr., et al, appellees,—from Lincoln county.

The state supreme court denied a writ of prohibition to Robert Mansker, sheriff of Union county, suspended by District Judge Lieb.

In the federal court on the motion of the government, the case against James A. Hamn, charged with perjury in connection with a public land entry, was dismissed. The case of the United States vs. H F Morris, of Santa Cruz, Santa Fe county, charged with selling liquor to an Indian, was taken up.
