

# SERIOUS INJURIES ARE SUSTAINED BY SHERIFF MANSKER IN RUNAWAY

Clayton, N. M., April 13 — Robert Mansker, sheriff of Union county, was thrown from his buggy here early this morning when the horse that he was driving became unmanageable, and received serious, but not fatal injuries.

Mr. Mansker's right arm was broken and he was severely bruised about the face. At first it was feared that he had sustained internal injuries that might result fatally, but after a careful examination physicians declared that the sheriff will recover.
